She obtained her PhD at Nikhef at the University of Amsterdam on Science Park with her research into so-called neutrinos, and in particular the big question of where exactly these neutrinos come from. The detector to do this research, called KM3NeT (KM 3 Neutrino Telescope), is currently under construction at the bottom of the Mediterranean Sea.

In addition to full-time research, Rasa is an athlete, and loves to spread the word of science on television, stages, or in the pub.
